Responsible for Right-of-Way (ROW) clearing and maintenance. Operates chain saws, chippers and other equipment in the ROW maintenance of transmission and distribution systems.

Typical responsibilities include:

- Cuts, chips brush and maintains existing ROW.
- Maintains and cares for tools and equipment.
- Establish and maintain cooperative relationships with those contacted In the course of work.
- Operates certain types of equipment and vehicles associated with tree trimming.
- Complies with all traffic laws, safety rules, regulations and practices.
- Reports any unsafe conditions to supervisor.
- Assists tree trimming crew in duties as assigned.

The physical requirements of this position are very heavy work, exerting in excess of 100 lbs. of force or lift occasionally and/or in excess of 50 lbs. of force or lift constantly to move objects.

Job requirements:

- High School diploma or GED.
- Maintain a valid New Mexico Driver's License
- Must be able to operate assigned equipment including bucket truck, pickup, brush chipper and chainsaw.
- Ability to work in all weather conditions. May be exposed to nature, bites and irritating plants. Able to tolerate loud noises.
- Ability to work on uneven ground for long periods of time.
- Understands considerable hazards that exist, including slips, trips, falls, electric shock, electric flash, automobile traffic and falling objects. Understands and utilizes safety and protective equipment.
- Learns and complies with all safety policies, rules and regulations.
- Ability to operate a computer, tablet for emails, assigned tasks and mapping.
