## Winter Season Disconnect Moratorium Notice

Protection from winter shut-off begins November 15, 2023. To avoid potential disconnection of service please contact the Human Services Department at 800-283-4465, or the appropriate tribal or pueblo entity for eligibility information for Low Income Heating Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP). Your service will not be disconnected from November 15, 2023, through March 15, 2024, if you meet the qualifications of LIHEAP and have no past due amounts or you remain current on any settlement or installment agreement for amounts due as of November 15, 2023. Members of New Mexico tribes or pueblos who need help with translation or with other matters may contact the commission's consumer relations division at 888-427-5772, who will contact the appropriate tribal or pueblo official for assistance.

## **Vegetation Management Update**

## Your Electric Bill Explained

Service location and account balance information.



Current meter readings, usage, and detailed charges for your account.

**System Charge** Monthly minimum charge to cover costs associated with maintaining the distribution of your co-op.

kWh Charge Cost for the energy you use each month based on current rates.

Fuel Adjustment Rate Billing adjustment to accommodate the changing costs of fuel used to generate electricity. This is a "pass-through" charge from our supplier, Tri-State G & T, based on what they charge OCEC. This fee varies each month.

**Debt Cost** Fee used to recover the cooperative's increase in debt cost since the present rates were set in 2020. This adjustment eliminates the need for expensive rate case hearings. The debt adjustment figure changes quarterly.

## **Energy Efficiency Program**

Provides fund for energy efficiency rebates, which are offered to members to help lower energy consumption.


